



## Clarence "Red" Gilbert

January 24, 1917 - January 1, 1753

Clarence (Red) Harvey Gilbert, 89, born on January 24, 1917 in Cambridge, Nebraska passed away Monday evening the 10th of April 2006 in Glendive, Montana. Present at his passing were two of his daughters, Stephany Flakker and Perri Eggert. Funeral services will be held at 4:00 P.M., Saturday, April 15, 2006 at the Bertas Funeral Chapel in Chaska, Minnesota. Interment will be in the Mount Pleasant Cemetery in Chaska. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive was entrusted with local arrangements. Red married Rita Claire Philastre on December 11, 1941 in Nebraska. During the war they moved to St Paul Minnesota where they raised their five children. Red was a tool and dye engineer for the Arms plant during the war. Later he worked for 3M Company. Red and Rita moved their family to California in 1967 where he worked in plastics engineering for Beckman Instruments. Red and Rita retired to Las Vegas in 1988. They moved again in October of 2000 to Chaska, Minnesota to be closer to their children in their remaining years. Rita passed away on December 12, 2000, the day after their 59th anniversary. Red lived with his son, Jeff, then in Savage, Minnesota until August of 2004 when he moved yet again to Glendive, MT with his daughter Stephany and her family. Red is survived by his four daughters, Renee (Ed) Simon of Las Vegas, NV, Stephany (Gary) Flakker of Glendive; Adrienne (Phil) Kern of Hawthorn, Wisconsin and Perri (Steve) Eggert of Chaska, Minnesota and his son, Jeffrey (Cornelia) Gilbert of Palm Harbor, Florida; 15 grandchildren and six Great-Grandchildren.
