August 30, 1917 - November 11, 2008

GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Clarence A. Steffen, 91, died November 6, 2008 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Visitation will be from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. on Monday, November 10, 2008 at the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be at 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, November 11, 2008 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church of Glendive with Fr. Joseph Ponessa officiating. Rite of Interment with military honors will be in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with the arrangements. Clarence was born on August 30, 1917 in Minot, North Dakota the son of Ferdinand J. and Mollie (Margert-Rusche) Steffen. He received his education at Washington School in rural Dawson county, the Steffen School, and at schools in Polson, Montana and LaCrosse, Wisconsin. Clarence graduated from Richey High School in Richey, Montana with the class of 1936. He entered the United States Army on October 3, 1942 and while serving in Italy during World War II he earned the Combat Infantry Badge and the Bronze Star. Following his honorable discharge from the military in November of 1945, Clarence returned home to Montana where he farmed the family farm 2 miles north and 3.34 miles west on road 428 near Bloomfield, for the rest of his life. Clarence was a life member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #7887 of Richey and the American Legion Post #28. He enjoyed baseball and was an avid Minnesota Twins fan. Clarence also enjoyed fishing and working with Moss Agates making jewelry. Clarence enjoyed collecting

arrowheads and had acquired an extensive collection. Clarence was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Fred J. Steffen. Survivors include, one brother, John W. Steffen of Glendive and one sister, Kathleen Eggebrecht and her husband Wilbur of Billings, Montana and numerous nieces and nephews.
