



## Clayton E. Hoyt

July 18, 1925 - September 9, 2010

GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Clayton E. Hoyt, 85, died on Thursday, September 9, 2010 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care. No funeral services are planned at this time. Clayton was born on July 18, 1925 in Ivanhoe, Minnesota. He was the last of the five children, four boys and a girl, born to Leland and Annot (Millar) Hoyt. Clayton was raised and received his primary education in Lake Benton, Minnesota. On September 25, 1943, Mr. Hoyt joined the United States Navy at Minneapolis, Minnesota and served until May 17, 1946 being mustered out in Minneapolis as a second class petty officer. Clayton attended River Falls Teachers College in River Falls, Wisconsin from 1947 until 1951, graduating with honors and a Bachelor of Science Degree. Clayton also attended summer sessions at the University of Colorado, University of Wyoming, University of Iowa and Eastern Montana College. He taught school and coached at Dawson, Minnesota from 1951 to 1954. Clayton moved to Glendive, Montana in 1954 and taught, coached and was Athletic Director for a time at Dawson County High School. Mr. Hoyt retired from teaching in 1980. Mr. Hoyt fell in love with Eastern Montana and it's people and stayed a lifetime to enjoy them. Clayton is survived by numerous nieces and nephews.
