Clifford N. Peterson, age 80, passed away Friday, May 2, 2003 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held 10:30 Tuesday, May 6, 2003 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Pastor Paul Everett officiating. Interment with military honors will be in the Dawson County Cemetery. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Cliff was born on May 5, 1922 in Crookston, Minnesota the son of Christian and Nelsine (Nelson) Peterson. He was raised and educated in Crookston. He entered the U. S. Army and served in the European Theater of World War II. Following his honorable discharge he returned to Crookston where he worked for Fylling Grocery and Crookston Paint and Glass. Cliff married Carol McLaughlin in Crookston on October 19, 1946. They moved to Glendive, Montana in 1956 and Cliff worked at Glendive Paint, Glass and Linoleum for many years. Cliff was then self-employed laying carpet and linoleum and doing carpentry work until his retirement in 1997. Cliff enjoyed working in his shop and square dancing. He was a member of the Crookston VFW and Eagles Aerie and he also belonged to the American Legion Club in Glendive. Cliff is survived by his wife, Carol of Glendive; two daughters, Kristine Peterson of Minneapolis, Minnesota and Laurel Dassinger and her husband Dan of Glendive; one sister, Dagmar Jasper of Crookston; and numerous nieces and nephews.
