



## Clyde Allen Campbell

September 18, 1927 - February 12, 2014

Clyde Allen Campbell, age 86, of Glendive, Montana passed away at his home on Friday, February 7, 2014. Graveside services will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Wednesday, February 12, 2014 at the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive with Father Francis Schreiber officiating. Clyde enjoyed riding motorcycle, being behind the wheel of a truck and the open road. He'd made many friends and gained a trusty support group attending AA meetings for many years.
