Cora M. Lovaas, age 90, of Glendive, passed away on Thursday, February 5, 2004 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Tuesday, February 10, 2004 in the Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Paul Everett officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Cora was born on January 3, 1914 in Glendive, Montana, the daughter of Royal Guy and Jennie (Stevenson) Fowler. She attended Lindsay, Montana grade school and Dawson County High School in Glendive. She was united in marriage to Erling Lovaas in 1931 in Glendive. The couple made their home North of Lindsay, Montana until 1934. In 1936-1937 Cora and her husband lived at Fort Peck while Erling worked in the construction of the Fort Peck Dam.
