GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Cora Lee Neiffer, age 76, passed away on Wednesday, September 8, 2010 after a courageous 2 1/2 year battle with cancer at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care. Visitation will be from 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. on Friday, September 10, 2010 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral Services will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Saturday, September 11, 2010 at the Church of Christ in Glendive with Pastor Richard Eggar officiating. Cora Lee was born on February 7, 1934 in Mannford, Oklahoma, the daughter of John and Crochia (Posten) Swart. She was raised and educated at rural schools near Mannford, graduating from Olive High School in Olive, Oklahoma with the class of 1952. While living in Oklahoma, Cora Lee was employed with Oklahoma Natural for 10 years. Cora Lee married Arthur Neiffer on July 28, 1962 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The couple had made their home in Glendive since that time. Although she lived in Montana she always loved visiting Oklahoma and never lost her southern charm and accent. Cora Lee was an integral part of the family farm west of Glendive, preparing delicious meals for her husband, kids and anyone else helping out. They moved from the family farm to Glendive in 1986. Cora Lee had worked as an Aide at Eastmont Human Services for 10 years and also at a Group Home in Glendive for 3 years until her retirement. Cora Lee was a member of the Buffalo Rapids Homemakers Club and was an

active member of the Church of Christ whom she and another lady started when she first moved to Glendive. She enjoyed cooking and baking for her family and others and always made sure the guests had the best slice of cake served on the best dish. She also liked to sew, especially dresses and doll clothes for her only granddaughter Jennifer (who hated dresses). Each grandchild received a beautiful hand-made blanket when they were born. More than anything she loved being a grandma to her four grandchildren. She loved spoiling them and was very proud of their achievements. Cora Lee was preceded in death by her parents and her son, Jonathan in May of 2010. Survivors include her husband, Arthur of Glendive; two sons, Steven and his wife Brenda of Havre, Montana and Stuart of Glendive; four grandchildren, Jennifer, Garret, Anthony and Jonathan Jr.; her brother, Bill Swart (Betty) of Oilton, Oklahoma; her sisters, Jewel Crawley(Don) of Gravette, Arkansas and Imogene Kirkpatrick(Tom) of Pratville, Oklahoma and numerous nieces and nephews.
