D'Lane enjoyed animals, the outdoors, four wheeling, taking

pictures of nature, watching the wildlife and feeding the birds. When winter came her hands rarely were idle. She enjoyed a lot of different crafts; her favorites were counted cross stitching, beading and making jewelry to give as gifts. She found working with wood and jigsaw puzzles fun too. She took delight in raising her children and spoiling her pet cat, Smokie. She found passion in cooking for her family and friends and attending rodeos and country music concerts. Each summer she looked forward to touring the Black Hills in South Dakota with Tom and their daughter, Denise. She was a member of the Zion Lutheran Church where she served as a deacon and helped at the Lutefisk suppers and the church fair booth. She was preceded in death by her parents, Joe and Goldie Hess; son, Bradley in 1996; brother, LeRoy and his wife, Bonnie; nephew, Daniel Hess and great-niece, Leann Pettersen.
