



## Dale "Dick" Hansen

March 21, 1931 - March 13, 2012

Glendive, Montana: Dale "Dick" Hansen, age 80, passed away on Friday, March 9, 2012 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive. Dick was born on March 21, 1931, a son of Bernie and Beatrice (Burgher) Hansen in Glendive. He was raised and educated in Dawson County, attending elementary school in Bloomfield, Montana and later Washington School in Glendive before completing his education at Dawson County High School where he graduated with the class of 1950. During high school Dick was part of the 1949 State Champion Football team and was very proud of that accomplishment. In August of 1950, Dick enlisted in the United States Navy. He served on the U.S.S. McKinley during the Korean War and operated landing craft to bring the troops to shore. After his honorable discharge in November of 1951, Dick came back to Glendive. He was united in marriage to Patricia Haas on August 2, 1953 in Glendive, and to this union three daughters were born. Dick had worked several jobs in Glendive before

starting his career with Shell Oil in September of 1955. His job took him and his family to numerous locations including, Denver, Colorado, Roosevelt, Utah and Sidney, Montana. Dick was employed with Shell Oil until they sold out to Coastal Oil and Gas in 1984. Dick finished his career with Coastal Oil and Gas when he retired on May 1, 1993. Dick loved hunting and fishing as well as collecting agates. He enjoyed boating, camping and traveling with his family. He had been to both Hawaii and Alaska and would have went back in a heartbeat. Gardening was always a passion of Dick's and he was very meticulous about his yard. You very rarely found a leaf on his yard. Most of all, Dick was a family man, he cherished the time spent with his children and grandchildren. He was a member of the Glendive Moose Lodge, Glendive Elks Lodge and Our Savior Lutheran Church. He was preceded in death by his parents; one sister, Betty Diegel; three brothers, Bernie, Lee and Steve Hansen; father-in-law, Adam Haas.
