



## Dan Frenzel

November 1, 1945 - January 28, 2003

Daniel Florian Frenzel, age 57, died Thursday, January 23, 2003 at his home in Glendive, Montana. A Vigil service will be held 7:00 P.M., Monday, January 27, 2003 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be held 10:00 A.M., Tuesday, January 28, 2003 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Father Joseph Ponessa officiating. Rite of Committal will follow in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Dan was born on November 1, 1945 in Dickinson, North Dakota the son of Florian and Katherine (Sigl) Frenzel. He was raised and educated there graduating from Dickinson High School in 1962. After graduation, Dan attended the Brown Institute in Minneapolis. Dan came to Glendive in 1964 and began working at Glendive Broadcasting. Dan married Carol Hansen on November 26, 1966 in Dickinson, North Dakota.. Dan had worked at Glendive Broadcasting for 39 years and was the general manager at the time of his death. Dan was active in the Glendive community. Dan had received an award which read, "Presented in deep appreciation and recognition of invaluable contribution and loyal dedication to Montana Special Olympics, MDA and Shodair". For many years Dan was the voice of Dawson County Red Devil and Dawson Community College Buccaneer basketball. He had also announced many, many baseball games from Little League to American Legion. He was involved in the Relay for Life, American Cancer Society, a Lifetime Gold Card Holder from Dawson County High School and was

Montana Broadcasting Hall of Fame Nominee. Dan also enjoyed bowling, golfing and had served in the Montana National Guard. Dan is survived by his wife, Carol of Glendive; one daughter, Nikki Mannin and her husband Larry of Glendive; two sons, Tawn and his wife Anna of Dickinson, and Taryn and his wife Rachel of Denver, Colorado; one sister, Kathy Fetch and her husband Mike of Green River, Wyoming; two brothers, Alvin Frenzel and his wife Irene of Spearfish, South Dakota, and Tom Frenzel and his wife Gaylene of Dickinson; his step-mother, Jenny Frenzel of Dickinson; 5 grandchildren and one on the way. Dan was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Marilyn.
