Dana Albert Simcox, of Glendive, Montana died unexpectedly at his home Wednesday, March 15, 2017 in Glendive, at the young age of 40. A memorial service with military honors will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Sunday, April 2, 2017 at the Break Forth Bible Church with Chuck Rushing officiating. Silha Funeral Home has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Dana was born June 4, 1976 in Loma Linda, California, along with his twin sister Heather Dawn Simcox. Dana was the son of Pamela Tara Harwood and the late Leo 'Jack' Harwood. Dana's family lived in Southern California until 1992 when the family moved to Glendive, where he completed his schooling and graduated from Dawson County High School.. In 1998, Dana joined the National Guards. He was a Specialist E-4 with the Army National Guard. He was active in the Guards for 13 years. He attended the Winter Olympics in Salt Lake City, Utah in 2002 with the Guards to assist with security. He also served with the Army through National Guards in Kuwait during Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Dana's daughters were the light of his life! His daughters are Katie Dawn Simcox, born to Dana and Kari (Stoddart) Cameron April 5, 1999. Kari and Dana then had Kyleigh Anne Stoddart-Simcox, born September 22, 2001. Dana then had two daughters with Kayla (Osborne) James, Tori Elizabeth Simcox born June 15, 2005 and Bailey Olivia Simcox born August 27, 2008. All four of Dana's daughters were born in Glendive, Montana. Katie and Kyleigh currently reside with their family in Buena Park, California. Tori and

Bailey currently reside with their family in Deaver, Wyoming. Dana really enjoyed spending time with his daughters whenever he was able to, he loved them all very much!

Dana worked at Doc-n-Eddy's as a dishwasher, then later as a talented cook for 7 years. Rose McFarland was easily his favorite boss he ever had the pleasure to work for. The two were very close. Dana also worked as a conductor on BNSF railroad, but eventually made a career working his way to Sergeant at Dawson County Correctional Facility, where he worked for the last 9 years.

Dana enjoyed fishing with his best friend, Tom Burke. Tom was not only his best friend but was a father figure to Dana. He and Tom were members of the Glendive Masonic Lodge.

Dana was a familiar face in Glendive and will be missed by the many people who knew him.

He was preceded in death by his twin sister, Heather in August, 1987; and his father Leo 'Jack' Harwood in 2005. He is survived by his daughters Katie, Kyleigh, Tori and Bailey Simcox; his mother, Pamela Harwood; and his sister Ann Harwood.
