Danny Beery, age 69, of Richey, Montana passed away on Saturday, March 22, 2014 at his home in Richey. A Funeral Service will be held at 1:00 P.M. on Wednesday, March 26, 2014 at the Richey High School Gymnasium in Richey with Pastor Vaughn White officiating. Interment will be held at the family farm West of Richey. A full obituary will follow. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Richey has been entrusted with the arrangements. Danny AC Beery, age 69, was born on January 15th, 1945 in Bedford, Iowa. Two years later he and his family moved to the family farm, west of Richey. Danny died in the house he was raised in just 67 years later on March 22nd, 2014. Danny was educated in Richey and graduated with the Class of 1963. Following high school, he attended college in Dickinson, North Dakota, where he shortly returned to the farm he treasured. At an early age, Danny met Clarice Knudson and married his high school sweetheart. They were married on June 16, 1965. Together they raised two sons, Rondel and Jess. Danny's days began with a cup of coffee outside on his swing, and his long days ended on that same swing with a Miller Lite. Danny will be known for his conservative ways, his work ethic, his sense of humor, his love for life, his farm, and the passion he had for his boys and grandkids. Life on the farm never came easy. Hail in the 70's and drought in the 80's taught him to be a very conservative man. During hard times, Danny did whatever it took to make a living, and he never complained. He spent five years in the oil field until he had a life changing accident. Danny taught his boys how to farm; they asked for his advice, they treasured it, but

because of the inherited Beery stubbornness, they occasionally used very little of it. Being in the same field at the same time with his entire family meant the world to him. He was a welder, a mechanic, a carpenter, and an engineer. If he could build it, he wouldn't buy it. His welding left him with no fingerprints, his mechanical ways left him with knots on his head, his carpentering left him with no fingernails, and his engineering left him with a completely wrecked semi at the bottom of his dam. Even with a few small failures, he led a very prosperous life. He was a good farmer, a very talented man, and one hell of a good father. Danny loved every chance he got to have his family together. Any company he ever had, when leaving, he gave them a "be good" or "see you later" and then waited at the end of the sidewalk until they were out of sight. He had a love for animals. The deer and pheasants in his yard, baby calves, his twenty cats, and his best friend, Toes, his dog, were among just a few. Danny will be missed terribly by the family he dearly loved. Danny was preceded in death by his parents, Harold (Peck) AC Beery and Frances Irene Beery. Danny is survived by his wife, Clarice Beery of Richey; two sons, Rondel (Lanette) Beery of Richey, MT and Jess (Angie) Beery of Circle, MT; five grandchildren, Danielle (Seth) Servais, David Beery, Brett Beery, Bryce Beery, and Alysia Beery; siblings, Sharon (Norm) Wilson of Blackhawk, SD, Dick (Phyllis) Beery of Circle, MT, and Tom (JoAnn) Beery of Hazen, ND; and numerous nieces and nephews.
