



Darl Delmont Grevious

August 22, 1939 - April 3, 2024

With heavy hearts we announce that Darl Grevious (84) passed away peacefully in his sleep April 3, 2024 at the Glendive Medical Center with his family by his side. Darl was courageous in his fight with multiple medical issues over the course of his life. His zest for life, kindness to all and his unforgettable dry sense of humor endeared him to all and will be missed but not forgotten. His family is comforted in knowing that he is whole again and has found eternal life casting his fishing line into the tranquil arms of his lord and savior Jesus Christ. Darl was a loving and devoted husband, father, grandfather, son, brother and friend to many and most.

Darl was born August 22, 1939, in Killdeer North Dakota to his parents Harvey and Minnie (Kummer) Grevious. Darl attended Killdeer High School's class of 1958. Darl was drafted by the United States Army in 1959 and trained as a jungle field medic. He was stationed in Panama and was honorably discharged in 1962. Darl worked various ranch hand and veterinary assistant jobs while he was courting his high school sweetheart Coty (Bice). Darl married Coty on August 20, 1965, in Killdeer, ND. They began their celebrated married life in Lamore, ND where he worked at Minnesota Breeders Association as a lab technician. While living in Lamore, ND, Darl and Coty welcomed their first child, Tammie. Darl attended trade school in Wahpeton, ND and embarked on his professional life as a plumber after he graduated. In 1967 Darl moved his young family to Dickinson, ND to start his first plumbing job at Nelson Plumbing. While in Dickinson they welcomed their second

daughter, Stacy. In 1969, Darl and Coty relocated to Glendive, MT and was employed at Wagner Plumbing and Heating. Darl and Coty moved to their family home 8 miles north of Glendive where they welcomed their two sons, Darin and Dustin. Upon the closing of Wagner Plumbing and Heating Darl worked for Star Service Plumbing out of Billings MT and retired in 1996. After retirement Darl and Coty moved into Glendive where they built a home on River Road.

Darl was active within the community of Glendive. He was a member of the Evangelical Church, was a longtime usher, assisted Coty in teaching Sunday school, and served on the pastor parish. He was a member of the Deer Creek School board and served as chairman and was a 4-H leader.

Darl loved his family and fishing...not necessarily in that order! Greivous' vacations most often revolved around fishing with his family and friends. Darl found tremendous joy in spending endless hours designing and making fishing spinners that were destined to catch the next record walleye, preparing his boat and scheming locations for his fishing explorations. In Darl's retirement years he and his wife, Coty, went on numerous adventurous trips to 48 states, including Alaska and Hawaii, and globetrotting to amazing destinations such as Australia, New Zealand, Fiji, Bahamas, Germany, Austria, Cuba, Czechoslovakia, and his favorite...Cancun, Mexico. The memories made with his friends are cherished and will always hold a special place. Holidays and family gatherings were near and dear to his heart. Having a chaotic houseful of family playing pinochle and phase ten were truly some of his most cherished moments. Darl found peace and fulfillment as a family man and was very intentional with his time spent with his beloved wife, children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. He enjoyed watching various sports that his family participated in. The life lessons taught on carpentry, yard work, camping, hunting, fishing while raising Christlike children and grandchildren were countless. His legacy of love, kindness, compassion, patience, and love for Jesus will forever be remembered.

Darl was preceded in death by his parents, stepfather Jack Olsen, brothers

Denver, Gerald, and Neil, brother in laws, and nephew.

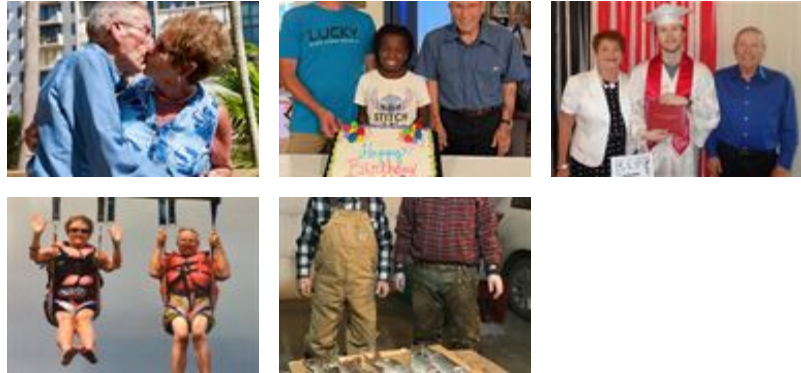
