Darleen met Donald Huber, her future husband, while he was working a construction job in Killdeer and they were united in marriage in Dickinson on July 5, 1968 and to this union three children were born. Shortly after their marriage they moved to Glendive where they started their family; Darleen was a stay at home mother raising their children and Donald worked for Western

Area Power Administration. After their children were old enough Darleen found work cutting meat at Reynold's Warehouse Grocery Store, later cleaning houses and apartments part time and finally working the lunch rush hour at McDonald's before quitting shortly before Donald's retirement in 1998. Darleen and Donald moved to Wolf Point following Donald's retirement where they purchased a farm and built their house from ground up where she had remained until the time of her death. Darleen enjoyed gardening, crocheting, quilting, plastic canvas projects, canning and she was a wonderful cook. She loved the quiet life on the farm, watching her kids sporting events when they were younger and spending quality time with her grandchildren.
