Darrel James Buller was called home to heaven on August 7, 2015. He was 63 years young and died of Interstitial Lung Disease after a long fight. He died in the Billings Clinic Hospital with Jan and his children by his side. Visitation will be held from 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. on Monday, August 10, 2015 at the Silha Funeral Home in Richey, Montana. A funeral service will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Tuesday, August 11, 2015 at the Christian & Missionary Alliance Church in Richey with Pastor Paul Sponheim officiating. Darrel married Janice Fried of Baker, Montana on December 27, 1972.

Together they began their life in the community they loved – Richey. They were blessed with their precious children, Kris Ryan and Karlene Renae.

Darrel's farming evenings became shorter once Kris and Karly arrived on the

scene. He really loved spending time with them – his kids were his life. He enjoyed following all of their sporting events and taking them on many fishing trips. He was a little biased of what he caught saying, “Keep those slimy things out of the boat!” referring to the Northern Pike. His preference was walleye.

Woodworking was one of his favorite hobbies. He custom made pieces of furniture for many people in the community as well as family members.

Darrel was especially interested in the next generation of farmers. He was proud of his nephews and so thankful for Colin and Devin who planted the crop as his health started to deteriorate.

Kris and Jess blessed Darrel and Jan with three grandchildren: Ivan, Anna and Micah. They were all with him the days and hours before his death.

Darrel was preceded in death by his grandparents; his father, Jim Buller; his newborn brother, Dennis Buller; brother-in-laws, Alex Jackson and Duane Ulrich; and nephew, Mikel Ulrich.

Darrel is survived by his wife, Jan; his children, Kris (Jess) and Karlene; his grandchildren, Ivan, Anna, and Micah; his mother, Carol Buller; his sisters, Judy Raisl (Butch), Bonnie Smith (Larry), Nancy Ulrich, Cami Mahoney (Ed), & Karen Moore (Jim). 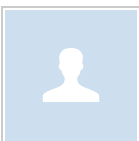
