MINOT, NORTH DAKOTA: Darrell "Pee Wee" Lee Reiter, age 67, of Glendive, Montana, went to the best fishing hole in the sky on Wednesday, June 16, 2010, at the Trinity Hospital in Minot. A celebration of Darrell's life will be held at 1:00 P.M., Tuesday, June 22, 2010, at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Reverend Avis Anderson officiating. Visitation will be held one hour prior to service at the funeral home. Military Honors will be provided by the Glendive Veterans Honor Guard. He was raised and educated in Minot. After high school, Darrell joined the United States Navy. He served on the USS Cowell for four years and visited various places, such as Korea and Japan. After honorable discharge from the military, Darrell worked for Boeing until 1966, at which time he was hired by Burlington Northern Railroad as a communication foreman. He worked with the railroad until retirement in 1999. In June of 1981, Darrell was united in marriage with Sandy Lipp. The couple moved to Glendive in 1983. During his time in Glendive, he belonged to the Moose and Elks Clubs as well as the VFW. He loved wearing his "flair-hair hat," his ponytail hat, and socially incorrect t-shirts. Darrell loved spending his summers at the lake with his fishing buddies, helping his good friend Kim working in the park. When not at the lake or watching his favorite sports teams, the Seattle Seahawks and the Seattle Mariners, he could be found hunting with his long-time friend, Tony

Schell. In addition to his love for professional sports, he sincerely enjoyed attending his children's and grandchildren's sporting events. He loved taking Carter and Chase to the hills by his house to look at all the deer. The weekend before his death, Darrell won first place in the fishing tournament at Parshall Bay with his friends, Kent Block and Rocky Schoopman. Darrell will be greatly missed by his friends and family.
