December 10, 1936 - December 2, 2003

BEACH, NORTH DAKOTA - Darrell W. Wolff, age 66, of Beach, North Dakota, died at Med Center One in Bismarck, North Dakota on Tuesday, November 25, 2003. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M. Tuesday, December 2, 2003 at the First Lutheran Church in Beach with Rev. Paul Peterson officiating. A prayer service will be held 7:00 P.M. Darrell was born December 10, 1936 in Harlowton, Montana the son of George and Lois (Fowler) Wolff. He was raised and educated in Ryegate, Montana. After high school Darrell attended Central Washington State College in Ellensburg, Washington, where he was active in ROTC. Darrell entered the United States Air Force in 1954 and served for 20 years, retiring in 1974. Darrell married Beverly Jean Odland in Beach, North Dakota on August 6, 1960. While in the Air Force, Darrell served in several places including: Iceland, Germany, California, Montana and Illinois. After his military service Darrell and his family moved to Beach where he farmed, ranched and operated the Homestead House and eventually Gramma's Kitchen. Bev and Darrell were in the catering and cafe business for 17 years. Darrell loved sports and participated in basketball and track in high school. He also played basketball and volleyball while he was in the service. He played on the All Air Force Team and traveled to other countries to play. Darrell was a member of the First Lutheran Church of Beach and had served on the Church council. He served on the Beach

School Board, Golden West Electric Board for 19 years and was the North Dakota State Vice Commander for the American Legion. Darrell was Adjutant for the Harley Salsman Post #5 in Beach at the time of his death. He was also a member of the Veterans Memorial Committee and was chairman of the Golden Valley Veterans Home Committee. Darrell was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Robert Wolff. He is survived by his wife Beverly of Beach; a son, Darren and his wife Greta of Bismarck; a daughter, Dawn Egan and her husband Mark of Beach; two brothers, James Wolff and his wife Betty of Cabot, Arkansas and George Wolff and his wife Doris of Billings, Montana; four grandchildren, Amber and Erick Egan of Beach, Travis Wolff of Bismarck and Airman Joseph Hogue of Dover, Delaware and numerous nieces, nephews and other relatives.
