Darwin Duane Diede, age 71, of Glendive, passed away on Sunday, April 25, 2004 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive. A Vigil service will be held at 7:00 P.M., Wednesday, April 28, 2004 at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 A.M., Thursday, April 29, 2004 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Reverend Denis Fournier and Father Joseph Ponessa officiating. He received his early education in Richardton and attended high school in Hebron, North Dakota. He drove for Harry Rehm Trucking until he was drafted into the U.S. Army in June of 1956. He served until his discharge in June of 1958. Darwin returned to Dickinson, North Dakota where he worked for Lubke Brothers. He was united in marriage to Elizabeth "Betty" Hauser on May 14, 1957 in Haymarsh, North Dakota. In 1959, Darwin and his wife moved to Glendive where he drove truck for Babcock & Lee and Houck Transport before being employed in the maintenance department of the Montana Department of Transportation where he worked for over 25 years, retiring in 1993. Following his retirement, Darwin drove the activity bus for Dawson County High School and Dawson Community College. Darwin loved visiting with friends, being near his grandchildren and following their Various activities. He enjoyed woodworking,

camping, and enjoyed being around livestock and caring for animals. Darwin was a member of the Moose Lodge, Little League Baseball, Good Sam Club and Red Devil Booster Club.
