



Delbert Riedlinger

August 21, 1932 - January 22, 2015

Delbert Riedlinger, age 82, passed away on Thursday, January 22, 2015 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive, Montana. A Memorial Service will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Monday, January 26, 2015 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Deacon Bob Ackerman officiating. Interment with military honors will be held in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with arrangements.

Delbert was born on August 21, 1932 in Hebron, North Dakota, a son of William and Martha (Scheuffle) Riedlinger. He was raised and educated in Hebron attending country schools until high school when he attended Hebron High School. Delbert was employed by the railroad where he worked on the B & B Gang until he was drafted into the United States Army in 1953. He served our country in the United States Army from 1953 until 1955 when he was honorably discharged.

Delbert began working for Ross and Powers Pipe Line after the military. He was united in marriage on January 2, 1956 to Irene Reinbold and to this union five children were born. Together they resided in Billings, Montana, Belle Fouche, South Dakota and Baker, Montana before moving to Glendive where they made their permanent home. In 1962, Delbert was a Partner in D & D Preventive Maintenance for eight years before he owned and operated Riedlinger Oil Field Service. Delbert and Irene purchased a farm north of Glendive where they continued farming that land until they retired in 1995. Delbert was a member of the Elks Lodge and the Veteran of Foreign Wars. He

enjoyed restoring old tractors.

Delbert was preceded in death by his parents; brothers, Elmer, Armin and Dennis.

He is survived by his wife, Irene of Glendive; five children, Rick of Glendive, Cindy (Raafat) of Cairo, Egypt, Marty (Teri) of Rapid City, South Dakota, Kris Gress of Wahpeton, North Dakota and Brad (Tammy) of Laurel, Montana; seven grandchildren and three great-grandchildren; brothers, LaWayne (Cathy) of Blackhawk, Colorado and Archie (Anita) of Bismarck, North Dakota; three sisters-in-law and numerous nieces and nephews.
