



## Delly Stundahl

February 22, 1918 - March 23, 2012

Circle, Montana: Delly Alton Stundahl, age 94, passed away on Sunday, March 18, 2012 at his home in Circle. Visitation will be held from 12:00 P.M. until 2:00 P.M. on Friday, March 23, 2012 at the Faith Assembly of God Church in Circle. Delly was born on February 22, 1918, in Flom, Minnesota, the son of Alfred and Hannah Josephine (Underdahl) Stundahl. He was raised and educated in Minnesota attending Twin Valley High School in Twin Valley, Minnesota graduating with the class of 1938. After graduation, Delly worked various jobs before enlisting in the United States Army in April of 1942. Delly served in the Pacific Theater during World War II in the Philippines, Australia, New Guinea, and Fiji Islands. While Delly was stationed in Australia he was part of a guard unit that was in charge of guarding General Douglas McArthur. Delly was honorably discharged from the United States Army in October of 1945. Following his honorable discharge from military service, Delly moved to Circle where he began working for the Railroad for six years. Delly met and later married the love of his life Lillian C. Hendrickson on August 30, 1953 in Glendive. As a couple they made their home in Circle. Delly started a career with Midland Lumber in Circle where he worked for thirty years until his retirement in 1983.

Delly thoroughly loved oil and acrylic painting and he was very good at landscapes. He painted the mural behind the baptistery at the church. Delly also liked bowling and playing horse shoes. He was preceded in death by his parents, Alfred and Hannah Stundahl; step-father, Louis Wanger; two step sisters, Myrtle Urness and Ebba Stensgaard; infant brothers, Delly and Alvin; brother, Sylvey Stundahl; sister-in-law, Elvira Hanson and Agnes Stundahl; brother-in-law, Harold Hendrickson and Joe Bozich and nephew, Steve Stundahl. Survivors include his wife, Lillian of Circle; sister, Violet Bozich of Seattle, Washington; brother, Vernon Stundahl of Billings, Montana; brother-in-law, Arthur Hendrickson and his wife Gerri of Clarkdale, Arizona; sisters-in-law, Dorothy Coil and Violet Schiffer both of Billings and numerous nieces and nephews.
