



## Dennis James "D.J." Cornutt

April 10, 1945 - March 28, 2025

Dennis James "D.J." Cornutt, age 79, a long time resident of Miles City, Montana, passed away on Friday, March 28, 2025 at the Miles City VA Community Living Center. A Memorial Service will be held at Valley Community Church, 1004 N Sewell Ave, Miles City at 11 AM on Wednesday, April 2, 2025 with Pastor Curtis Reese officiating. Military Honors will be provided by Miles City VFW Post 1579.

D.J. was born in Klamath Falls, OR, on April 10, 1945 to James and E. Harriet (Bruner) Cornutt. He graduated from Crater Lake High School in Central Point, OR. He served 21 years in the United States Navy as an E7 radioman. Following his honorable discharge in 1983, he was an outfitter in Meeker, CO. D.J. returned to the Miles City area and worked for local ranchers as well as for CHS, from which he retired in 2014. In 2007, D.J. met Jan Forbes McCuin and the two were married in 2008.

D.J. was preceded in death by his parents and his sister Susan Cornutt Niles.
