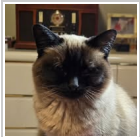

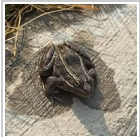

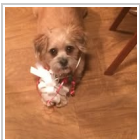

"I am devastated. I just found out my dear friend Dennis Getz died. He was one of the finest human beings G-d ever created. I am numb. He was the most sensible, caring, kind, generous , principled, common sense full, intelligent, empathetic, funny, decent human beings I ever knew. He was a former Democratic State representative in Montana...a Republican state, a retired RR engineer, A former bicycle shop owner, a very good son and brother, a former conservator of cattle and present land conservation activist , musician, humanitarian, former social worker.....and a breeder of quarterhorses of the DocBar (sp) line. I have loved this man and appreciated him....indeed his common sense, patience and friendship got me through many challenges. WE NEVER MET face to face. I feared we would be like that old film Charing Cross Rd....and now he is gone.
