Dominic John Begger, age 89, of Wibaux, Montana passed away Thursday, April 7, 2016 at the Billings Clinic in Billings, Montana. A Vigil Service will be held on Friday, April 15, 2016 at 7:00PM at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux. A Memorial Mass will be held with full Military Honors on Saturday, April 16, 2016 at 10:00 AM at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux with Father Navil Rodrigues and Deacon Terry Quintus officiating.

Dominic was born on October 29, 1926 to John and Helen (Watembach) Begger at their family home in Wibaux. He attended the South Center Country School and Wibaux County High. He began working for his father, ranching and farming.

Dominic entered into service with the Army in April of 1945 and was sent overseas to the Pacific as a cook. He was honorably discharged in December of 1946 at Fort Lewis, Washington. He was the last veteran that was born in Wibaux County and that still lived in Wibaux County from WWII. Following the war, he bought his farm and ranch where he lived the rest of his life.

Dominic Begger was united in marriage to Margaret Zinda on October 9, 1951. Shortly after they were united, he built a home, barn and several farm buildings on their family farm. To this union six children were born. He worked many jobs to supplement his farming income, road construction, building projects, and later became Wibaux County Weed Supervisor and served in that capacity for twenty years. After retirement, he continued his farming and ranching activities until his last days. Dominic enjoyed square and round

dancing with Margaret for many years. He was very close to his grandchildren and will be dearly missed.

Dominic was preceded in death by his parents, John and Helen; his brothers, Ed, Leonard (Betty), David, and Louis, and his sister, Sally (Joe) Bachmeier; his son-in-law, Jim Weaver and his great granddaughter Hailey Jo Ordahl.

Dominic is survived by his wife, Margaret Begger of Wibaux; his children, Jolyn Evertz of Joliet, MT, Mary (Doug) Lair of Big Timber, MT, Carolyn Weaver of Beach, ND, Janel (Bud) Ordahl of Beach and Mark (Helen) Begger of Beach and Brian Begger of Worden, MT; his grandchildren, Brad Ordahl of Beach, Angie (DJ) McCloud of Bismarck, ND, Abby Lair of Bozeman, MT, Grant Lair of Seattle, WA, Andrew Lair of Missoula, MT and Rylea Begger (Jayce Huffman) of Beach; his three great grandchildren, Alexis Ordahl, Jase McCloud and Jrexlee Huffman; his siblings, Elizabeth Morgan Brungard of Glendive, MT, Edevegen Abraham of Beach, Florence Finneman of Beach, Harry (Elaine) Begger of Wibaux and Ralph (Dorothy) Begger of Wibaux; his sisters-in-law, Cecelia Watembach, Janice Champion and Annisia Begger as well as numerous nieces and nephews.
