



## Don Fercho

June 28, 1931 - June 5, 2008

Donnie Fercho, age 76, of Bozeman, Montana, formerly of Glendive, Montana passed away on Saturday, May 31, 2008 in Bozeman. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Thursday, June 5, 2008 at the Assembly of God Church in Glendive. Interment will be in the Country Cross Cemetery in rural Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Donnie was born on June 28, 1931 in Lehr, North Dakota, the son of Albert and Lydia (Tarnasky) Fercho. He received his early education at a country school near Lehr and attended high school in Streeter, North Dakota. Don farmed with his brother Earl near Lehr from 1950 until 1952. Donnie and Elenor Wentz were united in marriage on November 22, 1950 at Streeter. He and his wife moved to Devils Lake, North Dakota where he attended Lakewood Park Bible School. He worked various summer jobs to support his family as he went through college. In 1958, Don and his family moved to Alfred, North Dakota where he worked as an interim pastor and also did work as a plumber. In 1959 they moved to Bowesmont, North Dakota where Don served as the pastor of the Assembly of God Church until 1968. He received his license to preach in 1960 and became an ordained Assembly of God minister in 1962. In 1968, Don and his family moved to Glendive where he served as the pastor of the Glendive Assembly of God Church until 1978. From 1978 until 1997 Don served in the Evangelistic Ministry. He then did interim ministry in various churches and at Grandview Retirement Home until 2007. Don also did carpentry work at Grandview Retirement Home. Don

retired in 2007 and he and his wife moved to Bozeman where he resided until his death. Don always loved the challenge of fixing things that wouldn't work or needed to be rebuilt. He enjoyed playing the "Fercho family version" of Chinese checkers with his friends and family. Don loved his wife, children, grandchildren and was always there to provide help to anyone who needed it. Don was preceded in death by his parents.
