Donald A. Pirrie, age 83, died May 20, 2006 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive, Montana. Honoring Don's wishes, cremation has taken place and no services are planned. Don continued to ranch there until the time of his death. Don was and member of the Veterans of Foreign War and was a past member of the Moose Lodge.
