Donald "Don" Hammond Brengle, age 93, of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on Thursday, March 20, 2014 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive, Montana. Visitation will be held from 9:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. and from 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. on Tuesday, March 25, 2014 at Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Beach. A Funeral Service will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Wednesday, March 26, 2014 at the United Community Church in Beach with Pastor Warren Maxted officiating. Interment with military honors will be held at the Beach City Cemetery in Beach. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Beach has been entrusted with the arrangements. Don was born on May 1, 1920, a son of Paul and Hazel (Hammond) Brengle. Don received his early education in Arkansas and in Buffalo, South Dakota and arrived in Beach with his family in 1937. Don enlisted in the United States Army on February 27, 1943 serving in the Engineer Aviation Battalion and was honorably discharged on January 7, 1946 and returned to Beach. Don proudly served his country in China, Burma and India during World War II. After his return, he went to work for Johnson Motor Company as a parts man until 1954 when he and his Dad bought the Ford Dealership in Beach. Don then moved to Baker, Montana from 1961 until 1964 where he operated the Ford Dealership. He then moved back to Beach where he went into partnership with his brother in 1965 and retired in 1991. Don met and later married Ethel (Aure) Dolwig on October 10, 1969 in Beach where they made their home together. Don was a member of the United Community Church, American Legion, Elks and the Beach

Chamber of Commerce. He was very active and committed to his community. He truly loved Beach and the people. Don always promoted Beach and its businesses. Don was preceded in death by his parents, Paul and Hazel Brengle. Don is survived by his wife, Ethel of Wibaux, Montana; two sons, John (Paulina) Brengle of Puyallup, Washington and Paul (Sandy) Brengle of Stockton, California; one step-son, Mark (Terri D.)
