Donald Faye Unsworth, age 80, formerly of Scobey, Montana passed away gently on Sunday, October 20, 2013 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive, Montana. A Graveside service with military honors will be held at 1:00 P.M. on Wednesday, October 23, 2013 at the Daniels County Cemetery in Scobey with Reverend Mike Hammerly officiating. He graduated from Montana State University in Bozeman, Montana with a degree in Engineering. After his separation from Sharon, he moved to Denver, Colorado where he met and married his best friend Peggy Ott along with her four children Cathy (Rutt) Martin, Donald/Butch Rutt, Mel (Rutt) Fjerstad and Susan Rutt. After retiring from Mountain Bell, they moved back to Montana to live in Bozeman. Donald loved the annual hunting trips with his sons near Ennis, Montana packing into camp on horseback, his horses and a trusty black lab by his side. Unsworth, daughters, Tammy Dickerson and Vicki Mosier.
