When they retired from the farm in November of 2002, they moved into Golva and lived there until August of 2025 when they moved to the Golden Valley Manor in Beach, ND. For a short time before her passing, she was a resident at Benedictine Living Community in Dickinson, ND.

August of 1971 and Scott in April of 1976.

Donna was a member of First Lutheran Church in Beach. She enjoyed planting flowers, crocheting, canning, and collecting Holstein cows. She sold Avon for 22 years and enjoyed getting the new catalogs with all the fun things they came out with. She liked visiting with her Avon customers while delivering their orders. She found pleasure in using her Avon income to give gifts to her family. Donna was a proud breast cancer survivor.

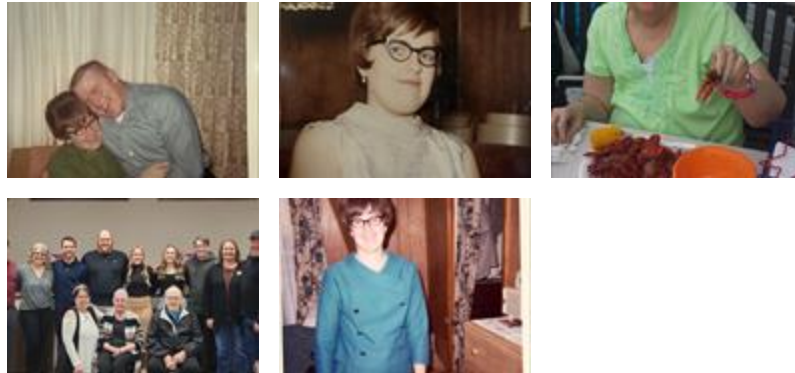

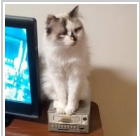
