Donna Mae Sygulla, age 88, of Beach, North Dakota passed away on Wednesday, February 3, 2021 at St. Alexius in Dickinson, North Dakota. Ted passed away in 1956 and the family continued to live south of Sentinel Butte until Willie's death in 1957, when Donna, Sharon and Diane moved to Beach. Donna was wed to Joe Sygulla in June of 1960, and they lived on the Sygulla farm until 2006, when Joe passed away. Donna moved to the Belleview Apartments in Golva, and from there the Golden Valley Manor in 2009.

Donna was a 4-H leader for many years. She always had a big garden at the farm and enjoyed canning. She liked making "scrubbies", quilting, and playing cards.

Donna was preceded in death by her husbands, Ted and Joe; her children, Willie and Diane; her brothers, Maynard (Muriel) and Charles (Jean); her grandson, Scott Schneider; her son-in-law, Gene Schwazbauer and her sister-in-law, Judy Fulton.

Donna is survived by her daughter, Sharon; her sisters, Janice Stedman and Marlys (Brent) Prince; her brother, Larry Fulton; seven grandchildren; nine great grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
