



Donna Yarger

August 8, 1925 - April 21, 2024

Donna Lucille Yarger passed away quietly in her sleep on Sunday, April 21st at the McCone County Nursing Home in Circle Montana. She was 98 years old. She is survived by her two sons, Floyd and Charles, along with five grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren. She is preceded in death by her husband Bob, grandson Casey and great-granddaughter Waris.

Donna was born in Bradshaw Nebraska on August 8th, 1925 to parents Floyd and Clarissa Quick. She was the third of seven children. When she was very young, Donna, along with her parents and siblings, moved to McCone County where she spent the majority of her life.

Donna attended several country schools before graduating from Circle High School at the age of 17. Because of the shortage of teachers, a program was developed allowing high school graduates the opportunity to teach school for 9 months during the school year and attend college during the summer.

Certification was required to continue the program and Donna participated for many years. She earned her Bachelor's, Master's, and everything but the dissertation for her PhD during the summers while teaching during the school year.

In addition to teaching school and working on the ranch, Donna was appointed by the County Commissioner to the office of Civil Defense Director where she served for several years. She was also very active in the Circle Women's Auxiliary.

She was an avid sports fan and loved to travel to watch her children and

grandchildren compete in events. Throughout her life, Donna was involved in 4H and taught many people how to block and show sheep at the fair. Although not widely known, Donna drove dirt track stock cars in her younger years. In one of her races she was going so fast she missed a corner and took out nearly 100 yards of barbed wire fence. She still won that race.

After she retired from teaching she kept busy making and giving away star quilts. She also enjoyed her roles as Mrs. Claus, the wicked witch and the Easter Bunny and continued to visit the schools, the nursing home, and local businesses on holidays.

After her husband Bob died, Donna moved to Circle for a couple years before settling in with her oldest granddaughter in Bozeman. She later moved into an assisted living home in Gallatin County and finally relocated back to Circle where she lived at the McCone County Nursing Home until she passed.

Funeral Services will be held at the Circle High School gymnasium on Saturday, May 11, 2024 at 2:00 PM with Pastor Owen Childers officiating.

Interment will follow in the Riverview Cemetery in Circle. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

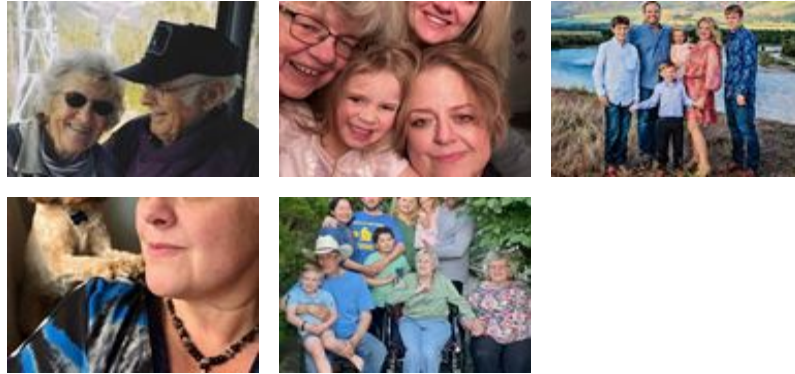
