



Dorothy Ewing

April 4, 1908 - June 5, 2007

Dorothy Helen Ewing, 99, died Monday, May 7, 2007 in Escondido, CA. Born April 4, 1908, in Fisher, MN, she lived in Glendive for 48 years, from 1947 to 1995. She was preceded in death by her husband, Floyd, on Feb 2, 1980. She is survived by sons and daughters-in-law Kent and Joyce Ewing of Cheyenne, WY, Neil and Patti Ewing of Las Vegas, and Ward and Mary Jo Ewing, of Escondido, CA; five grandchildren and twelve great-grandchildren. Mrs. Ewing was a homemaker who enjoyed sewing and reading. She was an active member of the United Methodist Church and the Frontier Gateway Museum in Glendive. She graduated from North Dakota State University (then the Agricultural College) in 1930, and was a member of Phi Upsilon Omicron - Honorary Home Economics Sorority. She taught sewing, canning, and other home economics skills for several years prior to getting married in 1937, and then she dedicated her life to caring for her husband and three sons. There will be a graveside service at 2:00 P.M., Tuesday, June 5, 2007 at the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive, following which Dorothy's three sons welcome well-wishers at a reception in the Fireside Room at the United Methodist Church in Glendive from 3:00-6:00, June 5.
