Geiger on August 31, 1946 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive. Following their marriage, they farmed in rural Dawson County until Mike became the manager of Butane Power and Equipment in 1980. Dorothy and Mike bought a motor home after Mike's retirement and did a lot of traveling, they went to Texas for the winter for fifteen seasons. Dorothy was a member of the Regent of Catholic Daughters, Court of St. Catherine, Regent of Daughters of American

Revolution, Women of the Moose, Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary and Legion of Mary. She was on the committee that started ACTION for Eastern Montana and was chairman of the Red Cross. Dorothy enjoyed crocheting, flowers, collecting rocks and fishing. She was an avid reader and loved doing crossword puzzles. Dorothy loved her children and cherished her grand kids. Dorothy is preceded in death by her parents, husband, Michael in 2008; infant daughter, Margaret Mary and sister, Valber Bryhn.
