Dorothy Idalouise Meidinger, age 93 of Glendive, Montana passed away on Tuesday, July 11, 2023 at the Heritage Assisted Living in Glendive. Memorial services will be held at 11:00 AM on Friday, July 21, 2023 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Greg Lucido officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Following the interment, a reception will be held in the church basement. Dorothy was born on January 10, 1930 in Glendive to her parents, Henry and Mary (Bush) Zimdars. She was raised on the family farm near Bloomfield, Montana where she received her early education. Dorothy later worked in accounting, first for H & R Block for a few years and then as the bookkeeper for White Drug until her retirement in the late eighties.

Dorothy enjoyed gardening, pulling weeds, quilting, knitting, crocheting, playing cards and PUZZLES. She also enjoyed traveling all over the United States with Willie. Most of all, she loved the time spent with her grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Willie, infant twins and five brothers and sisters.
