Dorothy Marie Stolberg, age 95, of Beach, North Dakota passed away at St. Benedict's Health Center in Dickinson, North Dakota. A Rosary Service will be held at 7:00 PM on Tuesday, June 1, 2021 at St. John's Catholic Church in Beach. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 AM on Wednesday, June 2, 2021 at St. John's Catholic Church with Father Dan Berg officiating. Interment will take place at St. John's Catholic Cemetery. Dorothy Marie was born on April 13, 1926, the daughter of Charles and Marie (Verdick) Michels, at her parent's farm two miles west of Beach. Dorothy attended the Beach schools and graduated with the class of 1944. She worked for the County Superintendent of Schools for two years and then worked as a secretary in the County Extension Office for Billings and Golden Valley counties for forty-five years under County Extension Agent Walter Mattson. She retired from this position in 1991. Dorothy was also treasurer of the Golden Valley Soil Conservation District for fifty years during the time she worked in the Extension Office.

Dorothy was a charter member of the Kopper Kettle Homemakers Club for fifty years, a life member of St. John's Catholic Church in Beach and an American Legion Auxiliary member. Her hobbies were traveling world-wide, with several trips to Europe, Hawaii, Alaska and all fifty states.

Dorothy was preceded in death by her parents, Charles and Marie Michels; her husband, Roger in 1975; two brothers, John and Frank; a sister,

Annabelle Edsall; her nieces, Renee Michels and Denise Globke; her sister-in-law's, Eleanor Michels and Alice Michels.

Dorothy is survived by her brother, Herb Michels of Midland, Michigan; sister-in-law, Clara Michels of Beach and several favorite nieces and nephews.
