



## E. Lucille Holderman

November 6, 1918 - February 12, 2005

E. Lucille Holderman, age 86, of Glendive, passed away on Monday, February 7, 2005 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility. Funeral services will be held at 10:30 A.M., Saturday, February 12, 2005 at the White Chapel Mennonite Church in Glendive with Pastor Neville Peterson officiating. Interment will be in the Red Top Mennonite Cemetery in Bloomfield.

Lucille was born on November 6, 1918 in Glendive, Montana, the daughter of Menno J. and Ora Pearl (Chaney) Mullet. She received her early education at Morgan Creek School in rural Dawson County. Lucille graduated from Dawson County High School with the class of 1937. Following her high school education, she moved to California where she lived for several years before returning to the Glendive area where she taught rural schools. Lucille moved into Glendive and taught piano, guitar, and accordion lessons. She married Ralph Holderman on December 24, 1961 in Glendive. Lucille and her husband moved to Oregon where they made their home for four years before moving to Pennsylvania where Lucille was employed by Johnstown Mennonite School as a secretary and teacher. In 1976, she and her husband moved to McMinnville, Oregon where they were employed as administrators for the Rock of Ages Mennonite Home. In 1986, they moved to Brownsville, Oregon and Lucille continued to provide music lessons until her retirement in February of 2000 when Lucille and Ralph returned to Glendive where they have resided until the time of her death. Lucille enjoyed crossword puzzles,

board games, reading the Bible and flower gardening. Survivors include her husband, Ralph, of Glendive; her children, Ruth Davidhizar and her husband Ron of Goshen, Indiana, Cindy Mullet of Glendive and Jim Holderman and his fiancée Mary Ann Burke of Glendive; four sisters, Jessie Evans of Glendive, Ruby Stanley of Billings, Montana, Gladys Kauffman of Bozeman, Montana and Eunice Field of Eureka, Montana; two brothers, James Mullet and his wife Belle of Guernsey, Saskatchewan, Canada and D.
