Earl Anthony Hollar, age 71 of Bismarck, North Dakota and formerly of Beach, North Dakota passed away on Saturday, June 3, 2023 at Sanford Medical Center in Bismarck. A Vigil Service will be at 7:00 PM on Friday, June 16, 2023 at St. John's Catholic Church in Beach. Mass of Christian Burial will be at 11:00 AM on Saturday, June 17, 2023 at St. John's Catholic Church with Father Dan Berg officiating. The Rite of Committal will be held at St. John's Catholic Cemetery in Beach. Silha Funeral Home of Beach has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Earl was born on July 2, 1951 to his parents, Francis and Marie (Nistler) Hollar in Beach. He was raised and educated in Beach, graduating from Beach High School with the class of 1969. Following graduation, Earl attended school in Wahpeton, North Dakota at the North Dakota State School of Science where he earned an Associate's Degree in Mechanics. Earl was united in marriage to Debra Maus on October 2, 1971 in Golva, North Dakota; to this union, three children were born. Earl worked a few odd jobs before starting his career with Burlington Northern Railroad. He worked for the railroad for thirty-five years until his retirement in 2012.

Earl enjoyed snow skiing and doing yard work. He was an active member of the Men's Choir, a longtime CCD Leader, and a volunteer at the Beach Food Pantry. Above everything, Earl loved spending time with his grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, Debra, and one niece, Donna.
