



## Edelia "Dee" Oech

March 21, 1911 - November 12, 2008

Edelia "Dee" Angeline Oech, age 97, of Dickinson, North Dakota, formerly of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on Wednesday, November 5, 2008, at St. Luke's Home in Dickinson, North Dakota. Visitation will be held from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M., Tuesday, November 11, 2008, at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Beach. Funeral Services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Wednesday, November 12, 2008, at the First Lutheran Church in Beach with Pastor Paul Peterson officiating. Interment will follow in the Beach City Cemetery. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Beach is entrusted with arrangements. Dee was born on March 21, 1911, northeast of Beach on the family farm, the daughter of Olaus H. and Christine M. (Ohnstad) Moe. She received her early education at Bunker Hill Grade School and attended Central High School in Fargo, North Dakota, for three years. She graduated from Beach High School with the class of 1928. Dee received a teaching certificate from Dickinson Normal School. She taught school at the Murray School by Rocky Butte and at the Oech School next to the Oech Farm. On October 31, 1934, she married Roy Oech in Glendive, Montana. Dee lived on the Oech Farm until moving to the Golden Valley Manor in Beach in 2001. In May of 2006, she moved to St. Luke's Home in Dickinson. Dee was a member of the Golden Valley Homemakers Club and First Lutheran Church. She was initiated into Chapter #70 of Eastern Star in 1935, and Dee was Worthy Matron in 1944. She was very active in the church and enjoyed many different kinds of crafts and quilting. Dee was an excellent cook and

seamstress. She enjoyed gardening and lawn work. She especially loved her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. Dee was preceded in death by her husband Roy on December 13, 1965, brother Harold Moe, sister Myrtle Moe, and 1 great-granddaughter. Dee is survived by her son, Darrel Oech and his wife Gwen of Beach, North Dakota; her daughter Vyonne Cook of Billings, Montana; her brother, Orville Moe of Beach, North Dakota; 7 grandchildren; and 13 great-grandchildren.
