Glendive, Montana: Edgar Justesen, age 83, passed away on Sunday, May 27, 2012 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Edgar worked for Montana Dakota Utilities for forty years; he started out working as a meter reader and ended his career, retiring as the electrical supervisor. He was preceded in death by his parents, Edward and Anna Justesen; wife, Anne Justesen, and younger brother, Roger Justesen.
