



## Edmund "Ed" Dietz

November 18, 1912 - January 5, 2013

Bismarck, North Dakota: Edmund "Ed" B. Dietz, age 100, of Beach, North Dakota passed away on Monday, December 31, 2012 at St. Gabriel's Community in Bismarck. After returning home to Sentinel Butte, Ed married Ethel Wassmann at St. Michael's Catholic Church on June 13, 1942 and made their home on the Dietz family farm. To this union, they had nine children, Ronald, Anthony, Judith, Michael, Marjorie, Shirley, Dennis, Linda and Melissa. Ed loved farming, enjoyed a good day of fishing and cherished every moment with his twenty-eight

grandchildren, thirty-four great grandchildren and two great-great grandchildren. Ed was preceded in death by his parents, Mathias and Helen; his wife, Ethel; two daughters, Marjorie and Linda; two grandchildren, Gage Schipman and Robyn Dietz; one great-granddaughter, Trinity Sweet and nine siblings.
