Edward "Ed" Emter, age 93 of Glendive, Montana passed away on Saturday, October 2, 2021 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care in Glendive. Visitation will be held from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM with a Rosary service at 7:00 PM on Sunday, October 17, 2021 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be at 10:00 AM on Monday, October 18, 2021 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Father Francis Schreiber officiating. Rite of Committal will be in the Dawson County Cemetery. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Ed was born in St. Joe, North Dakota, near Glen Ullin, North Dakota, to George and Rose (Doll) Emter. He was educated in a country school through the 8th grade, then farmed with his dad for several years.

In 1954, they moved to Glendive where Ed worked for the railroad for a short time before he began his career with the City of Glendive. He worked for the City of Glendive operating equipment like the street sweeper until he retired in the mid 1980's. Ed stayed busy in retirement working part time for the Ranger Review and Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home, until Eleanora's health required his care full time.

Ed enjoyed taking care of his cars and he was very meticulous about how clean they were. He also enjoyed yard work and was just as particular about how nice his yard and home looked. Ed loved watching his grandchildren in all of their activities, rarely missing one. Ed was a member of the Glendive

Moose Lodge, Glendive Elks Lodge and Sacred Heart Catholic Church.

Ed was preceded in death by his parents, George and Rose; his wife, Eleanora and one sister, Anna Glaser.

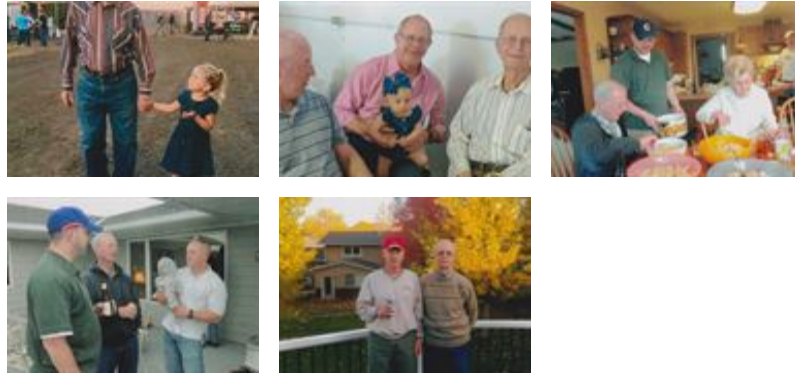
