



Edward "Ed" Novotny

June 5, 1922 - July 29, 2014

Edward F. Novotny, age 92, of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on Tuesday, July 29, 2014 at St. Luke's Nursing Home in Dickinson, North Dakota. Visitation will be held from 1:00 P.M. until 5:00 P.M. and from 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. on Thursday, July 31, 2014 at the Silha Funeral Home in Beach. A Funeral Service will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Friday, August 1, 2014 at the First Lutheran Church in Beach with Reverend Galen Strand officiating. Following their marriage, they moved back to the family farm north of Beach where he farmed for several years. Ed and Virginia bought the Beach Trailer Court in 1966 where he resided until the time of his death.

Ed was a member of the First Lutheran Church and was a devoted Christian. He enjoyed gardening and spending time with his family. Ed always made people smile and enjoyed life to the fullest. He spent many years working for the cheese plant hauling whey. Ed farmed, ran a gas station and a television sales and repair shop in Beach. He will be missed by all who knew him.

Ed was preceded in death by his wife, Virginia; parents and one sister, Marlys Mellmer.

Ed is survived by one son, Kenneth (Merlita) Novotny of Beach; one daughter, Jackie Lindberg of Beach; seven grandchildren, Chris Novotny, Alex Novotny, Kristine Cadwell, Taiann Padilla, Tiffany Cadwell, Mandy Novotny Henderson and Cierra Mogren; three great-grandchildren, Braelyn Henderson, Braxton Mogren and Alani Soliza and three nephews, Rick, Michael and Tracy Mellmer.
