Eileen Emma Buchholz, age 96, passed away on Monday, April 22, 2019 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux, Montana. A Vigil Service will be held at 7:00 PM on Friday, April 26, 2019 at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Beach, North Dakota. A Memorial Mass will take place at 10:00 AM on Saturday, April 27, 2019 at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church with Father Dan Berg officiating. Eileen loved knitting, crocheting and NFL Football. She always had pets, either a dog or a cat to keep her company. In the winter months, Eileen enjoyed going south to spend time with her sons, returning to spend her

summers in Beach.
