Eileen and her husband lived in the Hallson community, located west of Cavalier, North Dakota, until moving into Cavalier in 1959. They moved to Glendive in 1975 where she resided until her death. In 1978, Eileen and her husband started Byron's Construction which they owned and operated until 1998 when they retired. During this time they also purchased D

& H Oilfield Service. Eileen was instrumental in the operation of the Glendive Landfill, which she operated for several years.
