Dickinson, North Dakota: Einar Justesen, age 78, of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on Saturday, December 15, 2012 at St. Joseph's Hospital in Dickinson. Visitation will be held from 1:00 P.M. until 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. on Monday, December 17, 2012, in the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Beach. In October of 1954 he enlisted in the United States Army and was honorably discharged from military service in September of 1956. On December 1, 1961, Einar married Peggy Hartman at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Beach. After their marriage they continued to live in Beach until the time of his death. Throughout the years he was employed in the maintenance department for the Theodore Roosevelt National Park. He worked there for forty years, retiring in September of 2000. Einar thoroughly enjoyed the park and all the

people he worked with. He was a member of the Beach American Legion, Harley Salzman Post #5. He spent many hours repairing grandfather clocks for people in the area and visiting with his friends over a good cup of coffee. Most of all he loved being around his family, they meant the world to him. Einar was preceded in death by his parents; one daughter, Lana Justesen and two brothers, Roger and Edgar Justesen. Einar is survived by his wife, Peggy of Beach; three daughters, Cheryl Justesen of Beach, Dana (Jerry) Irons of Denver, Colorado and Beth Justesen of Beach; one granddaughter, Jessica Irons of Denver; one sister, Margot Jandt of Beach; one brother Eric Justesen of Belgrade, Montana and numerous nieces and nephews.
