Elda Violet Fischer, age 95, of Bismarck, North Dakota ended her journey on earth at CHI St. Alexius Medical Center in Bismarck on Thursday, March 28, 2019. Visitation will be held from 6:00 PM MDT until 7:00 PM MDT on Thursday, April 4, 2019 with a Vigil Service at 7:00 PM MDT at Silha Funeral Home in Beach. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 AM MDT on Friday, April 5, 2019 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Golva, North Dakota with Father Dan Berg officiating.
