Elden S. Christianson, age 76, of Glendive, passed away on Monday, February 7, 2005 at the Glendive Medical Center. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Thursday, February 10, 2005 at the Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Avis Anderson officiating.
