Eleanora Theresia Emter, age 89 of Glendive, Montana passed away on Thursday, May 23, 2019 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care. Visitation will be held from 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. with a Rosary service beginning at 7:00 P.M. on Wednesday, May 29, 2019 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Mass of Christian Burial will be at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, May 30, 2019 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Father Francis Schreiber officiating. Eleanor worked several different jobs during her career. Some of which were part time and a couple of full time jobs, including working as a cook at the Sacred Heart School and more recently she worked for seventeen years at Safeway Grocery until her retirement in 1985. During retirement, Eleanor stayed busy volunteering at the Attic and at the hospital with the Pink Ladies of GMC. She was also part of the Sacred Heart Auxiliary, helping organize

funeral receptions and other activities at the church.

Eleanor enjoyed gardening and planting beautiful flowers every spring. She was a lifelong reader, reading multiple newspapers cover to cover as well as many, many books.
