Ella O. Milne, age 96, of Glendive, passed away on Monday, August 11, 2003 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Thursday, August 14, 2003 at the United Methodist Church in Glendive with Father T.C. Chatman officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Ella was born on May 15, 1907 in Kief, North Dakota, the daughter of Herman and Minnie Eggebrecht. The family moved to the Richey area where Ella graduated from high school and then attended North Dakota Business College. In December of 1929, she married John "Jack" Milne in Richey. They ran a Standard Oil dealership in Richey, and then moved to Glendive in 1941. They purchased the John Deere dealership where Ella was the bookkeeper for many years. After their retirement, Ella and John spent many winters in Mesa, Arizona enjoying the sun and golf. Ella was a charter member of the Gray Ladies for the hospital auxiliary, a 50 year member of the United Methodist Church and a member of the Mary Circle. She was active in many community affairs. Ella enjoyed needlework, gardening and her grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband, John, in June of 1981; two sisters, Effie Whitmer and Florence Wilson and a brother, Robert Eggebrecht.
