In the 1940's and 1950's she did mission work at various places including the Hutchinson Mennonite Mission and Mennonite Service Units in Northern Minnesota and North Dakota. She also served in Saginaw, Michigan at the Saginaw Gospel Mission and the Ninth Street Mennonite Church. She was a cook at Hesston College for several years. She was always active in churches that she attended and felt it was important to be a member of those churches, When they retired, they moved to Glendive, Montana. Ezra passed away in 1999. Elsie moved to Kansas in 2001. She lived at Hickory Homes and at

Schowalter Villa. She was preceded in death by her husband in 1999 and her son, Tom and a brother, Wilbur Selzer. Survivors include her son, Dan and his wife Jo of Newton, Kansas; six grandchildren and two great grandchildren; one brother, Merle Selzer and his wife Lois of rural Hillsboro, Kansas; one sister, Alice Selzer of Hesston, Kansas; nieces, nephews and friends.
