Glendive, Montana: Elwood Holte, age 75, of Glendive, passed away Thursday, September 22, 2011 at the Sidney Health Center Extended Care in Sidney, Montana. Visitation will be held from 1:00 P.M. until 5:00 P.M. on Monday, September 26, 2011 at the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, September 27, 2011 at the Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Avis Anderson officiating. Interment will be held in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements. Elwood was born on August 9, 1936 in Noonan, North Dakota, the son of Odin and Clara (Vrolson) Holte. He was raised and educated near Crosby, North Dakota attending the Ambrose Schools graduating with the class of 1954. After graduation Elwood attended Minot State Teachers College where he received his teaching certificate in 1956. He then moved to Alkabo, North Dakota where he taught at Writing Rock School for two years. Elwood later went into accounting, working for Montana Dakota Utilities in Williston, North Dakota and then Natwick Decorators. He later moved to Beulah, North Dakota and worked for the North American Coal business for several years before moving to Glendive. While living in Glendive, Elwood worked for Houck Transport and then Fladmo Accounting for a couple years before starting his own business, Holte Accounting in September of 1979. Elwood owned and operated his business until 2010 when health issues forced him to retire. Elwood met and later married the love of his life Sharon Haugen on June 11,

1966 in Corinth, North Dakota and to this union five children were born. He was very involved in his children's activities coaching baseball in both Little League and Babe Ruth for twenty - two years, water skiing, and bowling. Elwood and his family planned a vacation every year for April 15. Elwood was a member of the Jaycees Club, the Elks Lodge #1324, Moose Lodge #949 and was President of American Legion Baseball. He loved watching baseball and was a big fan of the Baltimore Orioles. He was preceded in death by his parents, Odin and Clara Holte; sister, Elvis Gulbranson; brothers, Charlie Holte and Lyle Holte; and nephew, Marshall Wisdahl. Survivors include his wife, Sharon Holte of Glendive, children; Reed Holte of Glendive, Erin (Daren) Ellingson of Sidney, Lane Holte of Fond Du Lac, Wisconsin, Kara (Jon) Barthel of Glendive and Shay Holte of Broomfield, Colorado; four grandchildren, Rowan and Drew Ellingson and Konley and Keston Barthel; brother, Alvin (Tiny) Holte of Brundidge, Alabama; sister, Mavis (Charles) Mjoen of Fargo, North Dakota; and numerous nieces and nephews.
